Mark joined Aer Rianta in November 2000 as Director of Capital Programmes. Mark is responsible for Masterplanning and the delivery of the capital programme at Dublin, Shannon and Cork airports. Mark completed a number of consultancy assignments for Loctite in the USA, Puerto Rico and Brazil, and project managed the European consolidation of adhesives manufacturing operations after the acquisition of Loctite by Henkel.
