A non-profit organisation committed to developing education for young girls living below the poverty line in Cambodia.




REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS 2020

TFWA members who wish to nominate a project or cause that corresponds with the vision and mission outlined in this document are encouraged to nominate them and complete the application form attached.

Before filling in the form, please check the guidelines on the following pages. These will be used to assess the suitability of the requests received.

The more information we have about nominated projects, the better.





TFWA CARE PROJECT GUIDELINES

- Is there a **specific project** not just a charity or organisation to which TFWA Care can contribute?
- Are the beneficiaries of the project **people** (i.e. not animal protection, ecological causes) and in particular **women** and children?
- Does the project enable the beneficiaries to **help themselves** to improve their lives?
- Are you and/or your company already **actively involved** in the cause?

Key criteria

Please note that the following are pre-requisites to qualify for funds from TFWA Care.

Beneficiaries must demonstrate a strong link to one or more TFWA member companies, which should play an active role in supporting the project nominated.

TFWA will prioritise those applications that concern projects with a clear start and finish, for which our funding represents a substantial proportion of the overall cost (a meaningful impact rather than a "drop in the ocean").

TFWA will prioritise self-help projects that benefit women and children in particular.

Key criteria

Please note that the following are pre-requisites to qualify for funds from TFWA Care.

Beneficiaries must provide a clear financial overview of the use of the funds with comprehensive reports on the project.

TFWA will prioritise charities and projects with low administration costs.

Please also include any useful additional material that you believe may help your application, including project brochures, letters from the project organisers or their supporters and/or beneficiaries, photos, etc. We regret that TFWA is unable to return any additional material provided.



THE SELECTION PROCESS

Donations made by TFWA Care are disclosed fully in the TFWA Annual Report.

Deadline for submissions: 15 November 2019

Members of the Association decide an amount of money to be shared among the projects approved at the end of the selection process.

Oct. Nov.

In November, the nominations received are processed and assessed according to the selection criteria.

Deadline for submissions: 15 November 2019

Dec. Jan.

Members of the TFWA Management Committee vote for the projects they wish to support at a plenary meeting in December.

Following Management Committee approval, donations to approved projects are made from January the following year.
